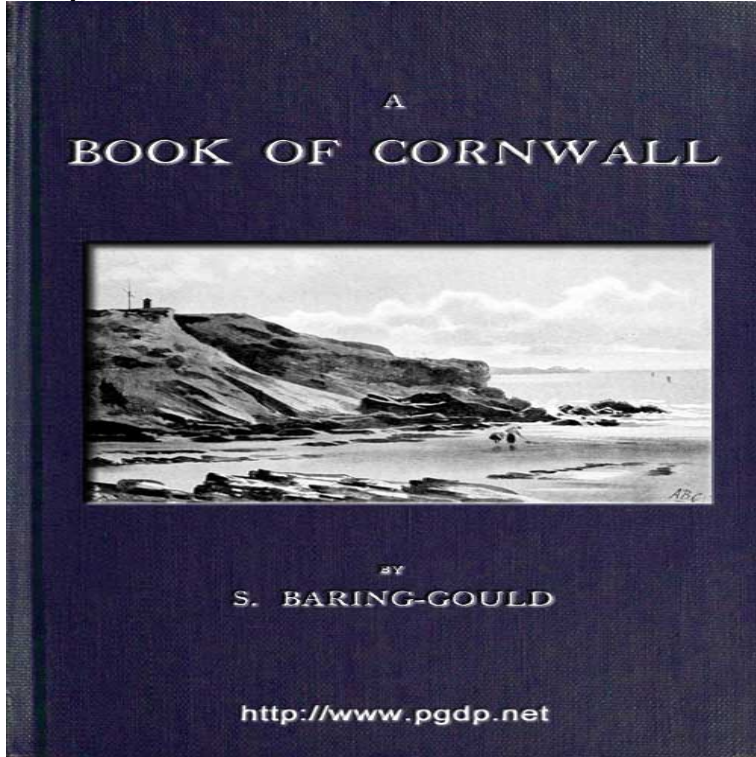


Capn Ancock: Ruler Of Australias Little Cornwall
