

Study Of The Professions: Legal Draft Report, October 1993

from asphalt pavement to traffic signal systems. Although the committee focused on just a snapshot of the program activities, principally those funded in FY 1993, it strove to examine them in the light of previous efforts, recognizing the continuing nature of the program. Moreover, the program continues to evolve even as budget priorities change and as new information and data are available, and as new technologies, both within and outside the highway industry, are developed and become mature.

Finally, it is also important to note the key role of the private sector in highway R&T. Private-sector consultants and researchers perform much contract R&D, and many private firms conduct and contract for research in support of the industry. In addition, the private sector is the ultimate user of many of today's highway research products. This report describes several recent public/private R&T cooperative initiatives while urging greater engagement of the private sector within the R&T program.

ORGANIZATION OF REPORT

To understand the highway R&T activity, one must first understand something about the highway industry in the United States. Accordingly, Chapter 2 profiles the industry as a prelude to the summary of existing highway R&T programs presented in Chapter 3. Chapter 4 introduces a framework for classifying highway R&T activities according to their underlying rationale. Chapter 5 "maps" existing programs on this framework and presents some conclusions about the overall balance of current R&T activities and where some redirection of emphasis is needed. Chapter 6 presents some suggestions and recommendations for the highway R&T program that reflect the committee's vision of the highway transportation system needs for the next century.
